

**STANDING RULE REGARDING PROOF IN AGREED CASES SUBMITTED
TO THE DISTRICT AND COUNTY COURTS AT LAW IN POTTER, RANDALL
AND ARMSTRONG COUNTIES**

During the duration of the current state of emergency in which the Office of Court Administration has suggested that Courts of our state utilize every effort to refrain from in-person hearings and non-essential matters, the Courts of Potter, Randall and Armstrong Counties hereby direct that all cases which are Agreed Cases as set forth in Rule 263, Texas Rules of Civil Procedure (TRCP) may, as an alternative to presentation of testimony by remote means, present the case on an agreed Statement of Facts setting forth all jurisdictional requirements accompanied by an agreed decree, judgment or order, each of which is to be signed by the parties or attorneys representing the parties.
